**Scarlett** - I enjoyed Samba with Miss Nunn and learning new steps

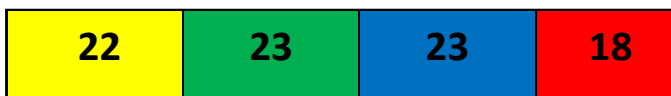
**Oliver C** - I have loved learning about place value in maths.
