

Art, Design & Technology and Music

In art the children will continue to develop their knowledge of colour mixing using primary and secondary colours, they will then begin to include textures to their designs creating colourful collages.

In Design Technology the children will learn about levers, linkage and pivots they will explore how these are used in toys today before designing and making their own moving monster. In Music the children will be exploring Jazz music they will thinking about the beat, percussion and instruments used.

Geography & History

In Geography the children will be learning about the wonders of the world, they will use mapping to locate them before learning about what makes them a wonder of the world and describing their thought and feelings about these. In History the children will be thinking about our Local heroes, what it means to be local and why these people may be special to us.

Computing

This term we will be developing our skills in using ICT to develop our typing skills, word process, edit and save our work. We will also use digital images to retell stories and capture moments in time. We will also explore how to create moving digital images by creating our own short animation.

English

Our key areas of continued focus in writing are sentence structure, punctuation, spelling and developing vocabulary. The children will be taught how to edit and refine pieces of writing. We will also be exploring how to write a recount and learning about the past tense. As well as thinking about how we can use our knowledge of information to help us present information.

Phonics lessons will take place daily and the children's phonological knowledge will be extended.

Maths

This term we continue to cover addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will use the knowledge we already have to help us solve one and two step problems. We will continue to develop mental calculation strategies and think about how we can use these to help us solve problems. The children will learn to tell the time at o'clock, half past, quarter past and to as well as using time to solve word problems.

Key Stage one Summer Year B

Science

This term, we will be learning to identify and name a variety of common animals, including fish, mammals, amphibians, reptiles and birds. We will also be exploring the structure of these common animals. We will learn about the definitions and differences between animals that are herbivores, omnivores and carnivores. As well as learning about the basic needs of these animals, we will also be finding out and describing the basic necessities of humans needed for survival (water, food, air etc).

PE

In PE we will be exploring how to move in different ways looking at different ways to dodge and jump. They will be exploring the concept of attacking and defending in the context of a game.

The children will also take part in athletics activities including races.

PSHE & RE

This term in PSHE, we will be learning about 'Relationships'. We will be identifying members of our families and understand that there are lots of different types of families. We will also be exploring how to be a good friend and learn to recognise good qualities in others. In RE, we will focus on Judaism and in particular the 'Covenant' and 'Rites of Passage'. These units will explore how Jewish people express their relationship with God, traditions, Bat and Bar Mitzvahs and share stories from their holy book the 'Torah'.
