Black plain shorts or skort, plain yellow polo shirt or tee shirt (preferably with Wheatcroft logo). Plimsolls.

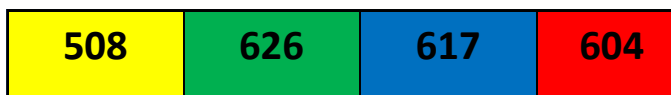
Outside
